

This course explores world history by investigating the past of humankind as a whole. Students will gain basic knowledge about the history of humanity from its beginning and its growing complexities to the contemporary era. Students will be able to conceptualize various aspects of human experience in a world-scale narrative. By recognizing patterns of changes in human society from a holistic and integrated perspective, students will gain insight into the large-scale and rapid changes we see in the world today. 6. Mileage allows students to register for courses. The more mileage a student bids on a course, the more likely that one will be successful in registering for the course. Checking the Mileage Result from a previous semester can be helpful to see how popular a course is. For courses that do not fill up, a student will not need to bid more than one mile to register. The mileage result for the course provides information on student capacity by major, by year of study, exchange/visiting status, and the maximum and minimum mileage spent.
